Sermon title: The Faith of Noah

Summary of sermon:

Matthew 24:37-39; Genesis 6-9

How one man's obedience, in the face of a mighty task, and amidst misunderstanding, derision and ridicule, ensured that life on earth was allowed to continue.

Discussion points:

1. Was there any part of the story which you felt God emphasized for you?
2. Do you believe the story to be true? If not why not?
3. What does the story of Noah tell us about God's attitude to evil?
4. 'It broke God's heart.'.....Discuss

Action points: *how can we apply the word this week?*

1. In what ways do the days in which we now live – resemble the days of Noah?
2. Is God asking you to be obedient to something He is requiring of you? If so agree to share it with someone and pray regularly with them until your journey into obedience is underway
3. Decide what is the first thing you must do in order to be obedient to God's will for your life. Do it!

Prayer points:

1. Thanksgiving to God for the scriptures and the heroes of faith.
2. Thanksgiving to God that He equips those He calls, however great the task.
3. For strength to stand firm when people misunderstand or even ridicule your faith.
4. Ask Jesus to give you the right words to say and the right things to do in witnessing to someone in the week ahead.
